At MLMC, we believe that everyone deserves quality legal representation. Unfortunately, most Massachusetts attorneys are charging \$200-\$400 per hour. How can working families afford this? While Legal Services agencies are a great source of free legal help, they do not have the resources to help everyone- only the poorest clients with the most urgent cases. In fact, most working people do not even qualify for free legal aid.

Attorney Rebecca W. Brodie grew up in Framingham, Massachusetts. She is a graduate of Massachusetts Bay Community College, the University of Massachusetts at Amherst, and Suffolk University Law School. Ms. Brodie began her legal career at the employment law firm of Attardo and Miller. Later she joined a well established North Shore law firm advocating for victims of traumatic accidents. Afterwards, Attorney Brodie represented hospitals, going up against some of the biggest insurance companies in the state. Ms. Brodie is an experienced ESL teacher and a former advocate at several legal aid agencies including Hale and Dorr Legal Services, Legal Assistance Corporation of Central Massachusetts, Suffolk Legal Services, and The Massachusetts Justice Project. As such, Ms. Brodie is familiar with many areas of civil law. Ms. Brodie's goal is to make quality legal representation available to everyone!

AFFORDABLE OPTIONS

FREE SERVICES

The goal of MLMC is to make quality legal services affordable. How do we do this? MLMC offers several ways to help clients access the services they need. First, over twenty five (25%) of our practice is dedicated toward providing pro bono (free) legal services to those clients who most need representation. Our pro bono cases are sent to us directly from legal aid offices all over Massachusetts.

SLIDING SCALE FEES

Another way MLMC helps clients, is to offer legal fees on a sliding scale. This scale is based on a client's household income. Rates start at as little as \$50 per hour for a paralegal and \$75 an hour for our attorneys. Approximately fifty (50%) of our cases are on a sliding scale basis.

LOW COST FLAT FEE

Some of our work is done on a "Flat Fee" basis. This means that for certain cases (such as bankruptcy), our office charges one set fee, not an hourly rate. At MLMC, we try to keep these fees affordable. Approximately fifteen (15%) of our cases are on a flat fee basis.

CONTINGENT FEE

Finally, in some cases, MLMC offers clients the opportunity to pay attorney's fees on a "contingent fee" basis. This means that the Attorney does not receive payment until the case is settled. Approximately ten (10%) of our cases are on a contingent fee basis

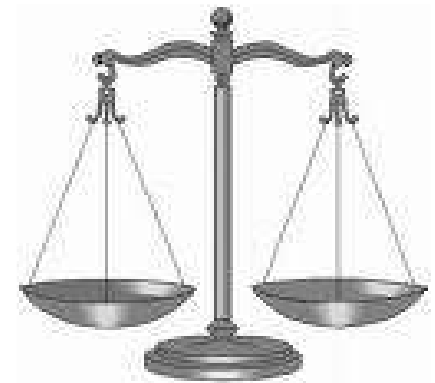
